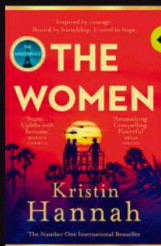
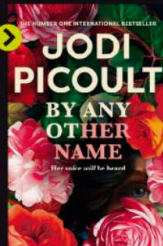


THE FALLEN WOMAN

by Jodi Picoult

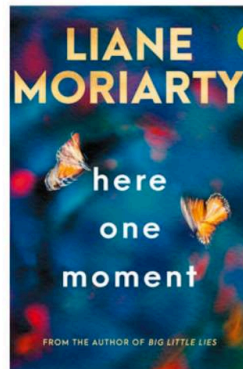

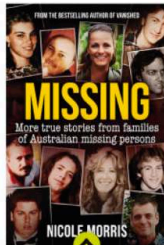
IN THE DEAD OF NIGHT
